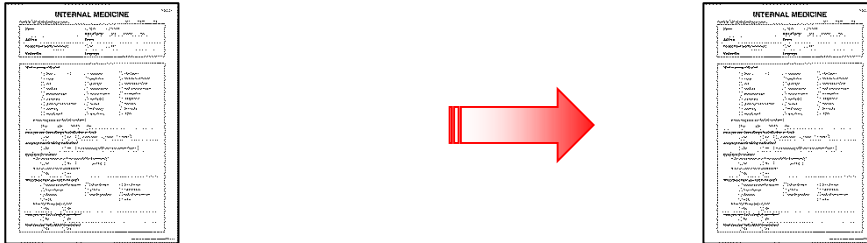


◆ Double Exposure

<Function>

This function combines the front and back sides of a two-sided document in to a single image. Then documents and a card can be scanned at the same time by selecting the card size which Double Exposure is applied

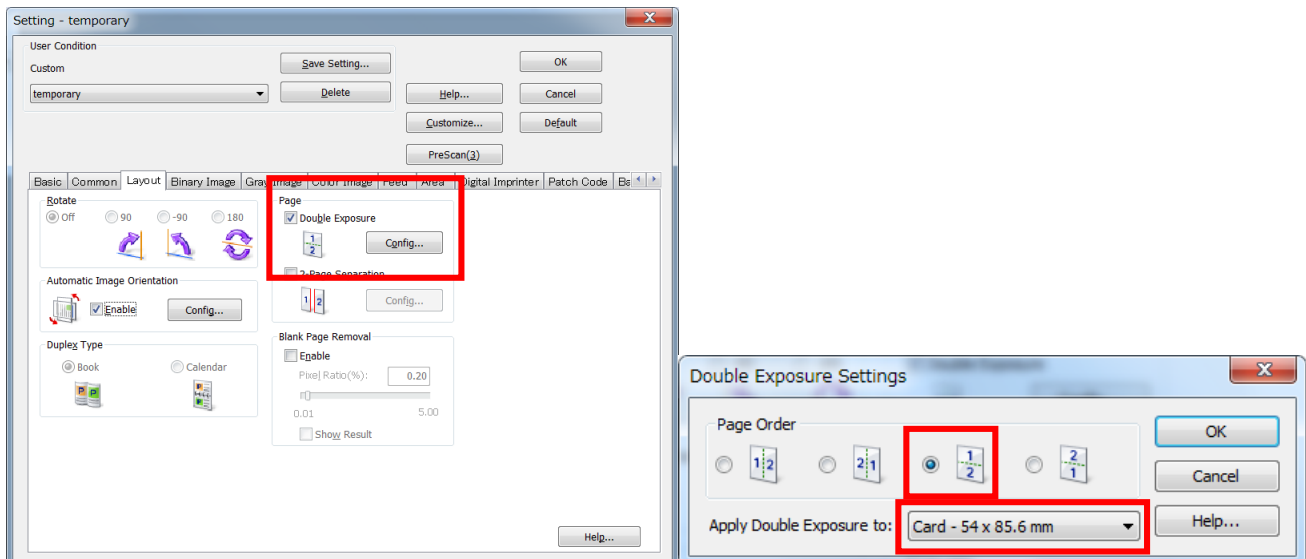

<ICP Setting Procedures>



1. Click "Scan"  at the left side. The "New Document – Scan" dialog box is displayed.
2. Click "Scan Setting" .
3. Select "ADF Duplex" in "Paper Source"
4. Select "24 bit Color" in "Image Type"
5. Select "Layout" tab.
6. Check "Double Exposure".
7. Click "Config" and then Select . Click "OK".

8. Select "Feed" tab.
9. Uncheck "Enable" in "Detect Double Feed".
*When a card is scanned, "Detect Double Feed" has to be disabled to prevent double feed error.
10. Click "OK"
11. Click the "Start" button to begin scanning.

<Notes>

- This function cannot be used if the paper size width exceeds A3 or the paper size length exceeds Double Letter.
- This function cannot be used at the same time as Control Sheet, 2-Page Separation, [ADF Simplex] scanning, or flatbed scanning.
- Set either [Automatic Crop] or [Length Control] check box to on when setting the [Apply Double Exposure to] list.
- Depending on the images to be scanned, the Hole Removal function may not work properly
